Chris King is Emeritus Professor of Earth Science Education at Keele University. He is Chair of the International Union of Geological Sciences Commission on Geoscience Education (IUGS-COGE), Chair of the Education Committee of the European Geosciences Union (EGU) and a Senior Officer of the International Geoscience Education Organisation (IGEO). He trains geology teachers in initial teacher education and directs the Earth Science Education Unit which has so far provided teaching workshops to

nearly 40,000 science and geography teachers across the UK. He co-runs the Earthlearningidea website, publishing teaching ideas regularly, with more than 40,000 global downloads per month.

He is responsible for writing the IGEO textbook addressing the International Geoscience Syllabus prepared by IGEO. He has presented keynote lectures and workshops in many countries and has more than 200 publications.
